**Summary of 2019 Updates**

**Program Updates:** Since 2018, NYCLA has continued to work with SEA, LEA and charter schools across the nation. This year, much of its work has focused on “helping systems build the capacity of school and district leaders to advance equity for students.” In particular, in May 2019 NYCLA published its [Equity at Work](#) strategic planning guide, which supports school system leaders in developing and implementing strategic action plans for closing persistent achievement and opportunity gaps.” NYCLA is working within Denver Public Schools on developing equity-minded leaders. It also continues to work across the country on talent development and pipeline initiatives.

**Evidence Updates:** NYCLA provided self-report perception data from several engagements indicating that participants and partners are finding their work valuable and helpful. NYCLA self-assesses that it has a Tier 2 and 4 evidence base for its interventions--however, for its Tier 2 evidence, the organization cites research done on similar practices by other organizations, rather than NYCLA’s specific implementation.
