Some Basic Ground Rules

- Pay attention to the year
- Pay attention to the entity selection (state, district, school)
- Pay attention to the inclusion and exclusion rules
- Use the most appropriate data source to answer your questions
- Use an iterative process to dive deeper
- Identify the best comparison group(s)
 - State? Other school or district? Schools in other districts? Grade levels?
- When possible, use multiple years of data and a BOE
- Document your process
- Validate analyses before drawing conclusions

What to Avoid

- Don't merge data across sources without the right level of understanding of the data included in each file
- Don't misinterpret the data ~ read into it more than what it says
- Don't forget any caveats provided on the data source
- Don't hesitate to ask for help

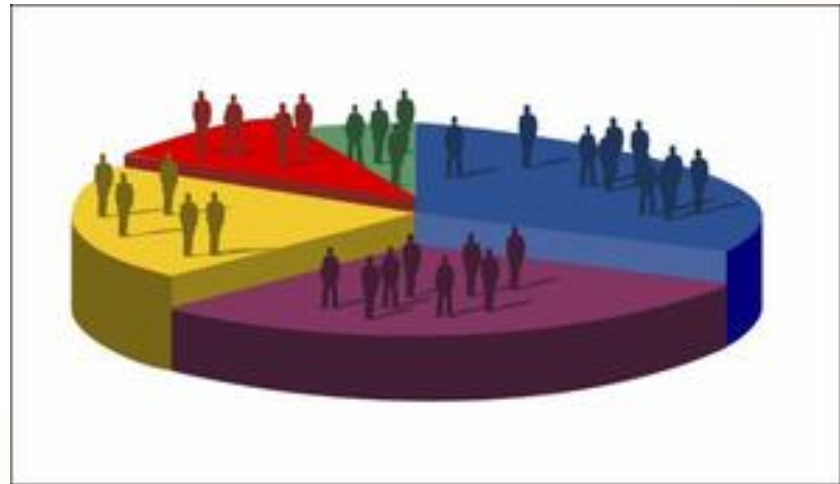

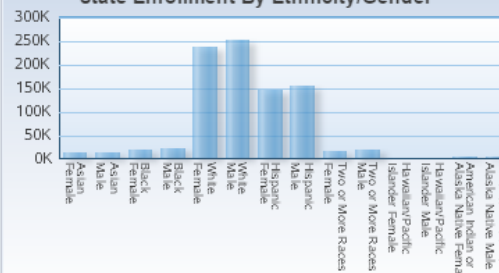

Each fall local education agencies provide to the department October enrollment information about the students to whom educational services are being provided. The count of students is certified by the secretary of the local board of education according to the provisions of 22-54-112 C.R.S. Pupil counts data can be broken down into various categories such as grade, race/ethnicity, gender, economically disadvantaged, gifted and talented, English language learners, migrant and students with disabilities.

Data Center Enrollment counts exclude detention centers. Data Center Enrollment counts also exclude school code '0000', a code used when there is no building associated with a school, and school code '0001', a code used when students receive educational services in a non-district location in collaboration with a private, non-profit agency.

- **While CMAS assessments are only one measure of student learning, having all Colorado students take this set of assessments provides parents with answers to these important questions:**
 - How well is my child doing on meeting state standards compared to other students?
 - Which schools and districts perform best in preparing students for success in meeting the state standards?
 - Which districts have the best performance on the state standards for children from various populations of students?
 - English learners, students from various races including but not limited to American Indian, Alaska Native, Hawaiian Native or Pacific Islanders, students with disabilities, migrant students, students who qualify for free or reduced meals
- **Additionally, state assessment results provide:**
 - information educators need to help improve instruction.
 - identification of districts and schools that have struggling students, so help can be provided.
 - recognition of high performing systems so others may learn from them.

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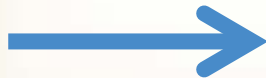
