Dear Superintendents and BOCES Executive Directors,

Happy Friday! I hope you are all hanging in there—I know this has been an incredible trying time and everyone's reserves are very, very low. I hope you all get a little rest this weekend.

I wanted to give you an update on some supplemental allocations we made with the ESSER I and ESSER II funds (see attachment). This is not the entire 10% ESSER II set aside—this is just a portion that we have allocated for high needs populations across the state.

These allocations were developed based upon ongoing State Board and stakeholder input. Similar to the first distribution of state set-aside funds, a portion of the state set-aside funds will be allocated to support underserved populations and educational organizations that have received limited funding to respond to COVID. This includes funds for:

- Districts that did not receive an allocation, or received a very small allocation, from the 90% ESSER II LEA allocation, as well as funds for districts to support Native American students.
- The two Colorado Tribes, to support educational needs.
- Administrative Units, to provide supplemental special education funding.
- BOCES, to provide operational support for all BOCES as well as additional funds for BOCES with brick-andmortar schools.
- Support for online courses that districts may use to supplement in-person learning.
- Facility schools, to provide operational support.

The above funding will be made available via the online ESSER II application. Eligible districts, BOCES, Administrative Units, Tribes and facility schools will be notified when the system has been updated to include these awards.
