Earlier today, we received news of the Executive Order entitled <u>Improving Education</u> <u>Outcomes by Empowering Parents, States, and Communities</u>. Furthermore, many of the most impactful programs funded through the US Department of Education, including Title I and IDEA, are statutorily required.
