To be considered for the Commissioner's Teacher Cabinet, educators must have at least three years of experience in the classroom and must submit an application, resume and two letters of recommendation to CDE by Aug. 15, 2019. Selected educators will serve two years on the cabinet beginning in August 2019.

Teachers will be selected by a diverse committee, including the current Teacher of the Year Meg Cypress, the commissioner, and other external stakeholders.
