The final totals for the 2023 session were 617 bills, 311 from the House and 306 from the Senate. 260 bills passed this session. Big issues this year were:

S.B. 23-258 Consolidating Authorization of Educator Preparation Programs

- Consolidates the review and approval process for educator preparation programs from Colorado Department of Higher Education to the State Board of Education and CDE.
- Creates an advisory committee with representatives from the education field to provide input to the State Board of Education and CDE on topics related to educator preparation and quality.
- Work with CDHE and stakeholders ensured that the bill was nearly unanimous at every point in the process:
 - Senate Education 7-0
 - Senate Appropriations 7-0
 - Senate Committee of the Whole 34-0-1
 - House Education 11-0
 - House Appropriations 11-0
 - House Committee of the Whole 61-2-2

Bills by Key Initiative
