- **Column 1** Under the special Education funding formula, administrative units will receive \$1,882.59 for each child with disabilities that was reported on the prior year December 1st special education count
- **Column 2** Tier B per student amounts are calculated using the ECEA state funds remaining after the \$1,882.59 from the **Column 1** above is calculated (up to a maximum \$6,000 per student) and will be distributed to the administrative units for a percentage of the children reported on the prior year December 1st count with the following disabilities:
 - o Visual Impairment, including blindness
 - o Hearing Impairment, including deafness
 - o Deaf-blindness
 - o Serious Emotional Disability
 - o Autism Spectrum Disorders
 - o Traumatic Brain Injury
 - o Multiple Disabilities
 - o Intellectual Disability
