The Colorado Education Initiative is pleased to provide a grant to the Colorado Department of Education (CDE) in the amount of \$215,839 for the Accelerator Project. This letter outlines the key components of the grant, which are further detailed in Memorandum of Understanding.

Grant Amount and Period

This grant is for \$215,839 from December 1, 2014 to December 31, 2015.

Grant Description

The purpose of the Accelerator Project is to sustain and accelerate current efforts to implement the Colorado Academic Standards, assessments, and educator evaluation systems and to capture and share best practices.

Grant Outcomes

Grant Outcome 1: By the end of 2015, 4,000 Colorado teachers shift their instruction to support student mastery of the CAS.

Grant Outcome 2: By the end of 2015, roughly 20 percent of the 178 school districts in Colorado demonstrate increased evidence of becoming responsive systems that are able to respond to, support, and enable educator and student learning.

Grant Outcome 3: There is increased understanding of standards, assessments, and evaluation among educators and the community.
