ESSA – NCLB Variance 2016-17



Attached is an illustration for discussion purposes of allocations under No Child Left Behind (NCLB) and Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). The attached illustration compares 2016-17 Title I and Title II allocations under NCLB versus 2016-17 allocations IF they were funded under ESSA. The assumptions for the illustration are below. Note that these are only illustrations, and that these are not for planning purposes.

Using the 2016-17 Revised Final Allocations, the Colorado Department of Education (CDE) applied the following criteria to the Local Educational Agencies (LEAs):

Title IA

NCLB Allocation

4% School Improvement Set Aside Hold Harmless provisions in place

ESSA Allocation

7% School Improvement Set Aside Hold Harmless provisions may be reduced

Title IIA

NCLB Allocation

The first \$21 million of Title II have been the same allocation to LEAs since 2001

The excess of the \$21 million has been split using an 80/20 split of poverty and populations ESSA Allocation

Allocations use US Census information based upon an 80/20 split of poverty and populations. This data is the same as used for Title I allocations.

This analysis is for illustration purposes only and are not reflective of final allocations for 2017-18. These numbers will change due to final federal allocations for 2017-18, in addition to final rules and guidance for ESSA.
