The Denver Metro Area includes 432,730 (55.42%) of the state's total Fall 2005 student membership (780,708) in public schools. From Fall 1995 to Fall 2005 student membership in the Denver Metro Area increased by 81,109 students (23.07%). The total increase for all other Colorado school districts during that period was 42,945 students (14.10%).

* NOTE: Detention Center students were removed from the district count and pulled into a separate category. Although detention center students receive educational services from school district employees, school districts have no jurisdiction over any other detention center function.
