### Example Multiple Choice Questions (4/18)

This document was developed to provide practice for candidates taking the Colorado Braille Competency Test. The UEB Practice test items address braille code and stress the importance of proof reading skills which are necessary for the Colorado Braille Competency Test. Some proof reading questions contain a high number of errors to note. This is not typical of the actual questions on the Colorado Braille Competency Test, but designed this way specifically for this practice test to provide a focus on proofreading skills.
