



## Frontline Updates

---

### September Quarterly Release

Frontline will be releasing version 18.3 in October 2018, the 18.3 releases will include:

- Enrich will now perform a cross-check for duplicate LASIDs in student records when a data collection is run. If more than one student returned on the State Collection for an AU has the same LASID and/or SASID, the system will display a validation error on the student records.
- The 2018-2019 Data Pipeline will open at this release to allow reporting for the current year.
- The matrix of services plan calculation for Special Considerations is updated

### Training

Frontline trainings continued in September with a System Administrator training refresher occurring on the Western slope, Southern Colorado and in the Metro Area. Additional training opportunities are being explored for later in the fall.

### Requests in process

Frontline is addressing the following requests by CESUG:

- Identifying what types of images are allowable in Enrich that will also work for electronic transfers. Districts are having various levels of success in transferring images.
- Adding a Service Plan Review or alternatively named ISP Services plan to the meeting purposes list
