- 2023-2024 facilitations to date (April 10, 2024):
 - 115 requests submitted so far (20% above this time last year).
 - o 118 survey responses completed so far (28% above last year).

Updates from the State Board of Education - Deb Scheffel, State Board of Education Liaison

- The board is continuing to work on the standards.
- CSEAC brought HB24-1296 to Dr. Scheffel's attention.

Information Session: HB22-1376 - William Brown, Affective Needs/Serious Emotional Disability Specialist

- Bill deals with seclusion and restraint.
 - Supportive Learning Environments for K-12 Students, requires revisions to the Protection of Persons from Restraint Act (PPRA).
 - Restraint rules apply to all students, but of all restraints in Colorado 78% on students with disabilities. (The numbers are similar nationally.)
 - o The Department of Education shall create and implement rigorous standards for training school staff and administrators on the "Protection of Individuals from Restraint and Seclusion."
