


Significant Support Needs (SSN) Book Study Opportunity

We will be holding a weekly **Virtual** Book Study on the book, *Comprehensive Literacy for ALL: Teaching Students with Significant Disabilities to Read and Write* by Karen Erickson and David Koppenhaver, 2020. This is an amazing opportunity to learn and network with your colleagues across the state.

This book study group is for school personnel who provide literacy instruction (planning, preparation, delivery) for students who are working towards the alternate achievement standards or EEOs.
