



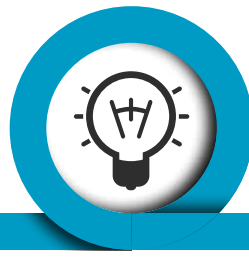
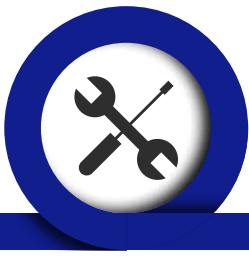

Develop



effective teaming structures for the upper tiers, and network with other teams from around the state



Identify



situations in which a FBA is necessary, a variety of behavior strategies and interventions, and the necessary components of an effective BIP



Explain



the difference between a basic FBA and a complex FBA, and the importance of family-school partnerships



Practice



the completion of FBAs and BIPs using a case example with feedback



Classes



Are held March 1st, 2020 through May 4th, 2020 (8 weeks not including spring break).

Purpose



To support the team in developing a functional behavioral assessment (FBA) that accurately identifies a student's function of behavior in order to develop more effective Behavior Intervention Plans (BIPs). Team-based approaches for such activities are always best practice and in the best interest of the student, school and family. Teams will be able to successfully complete basic FBAs and BIPs. Support from instructions will be given in the form of a discussion board (no face-to-face opportunities are provided).

Teams Must



- ✓ Register as a team of 3 to 6 school- or district-level members, including a special education teacher and a mental health staff.
- ✓ Have access to students in a school setting, and approval from administrators to complete a FBA/BIP case study on students.
- ✓ Commit to completing weekly reading, assignments, online discussions, as well as a case study in a school setting.
