



# Registered Behavior Technician (RBT)™

**July 7th, 2022- December 30th, 2022** Online Learning

## Overview

This 40+ hour readiness training is a **free**, self-directed, online training that fulfills the Behavior Analyst Certification Board's (BACB) eligibility training requirements toward attaining a Registered Behavior Technician™ (RBT™) credential. An RBT is a paraprofessional, teacher or practitioner who practices under the close, ongoing supervision of a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) or Board Certified Assistant Behavior Analyst (BCaBA). The RBT is primarily responsible for the direct implementation of behavior-analytic services, but does not design intervention or assessment plans. Other participants who might be interested in going through the course for content include: parents, school psychologists, social workers, counselors, speech-language pathologists, occupational therapists, school intervention team members, direct-care staff working in schools, homes or clinical settings, etc. The curriculum will fulfill the BACB RBT Task List <http://bacb.com/rbt-task-list/> standards.

All lessons must be completed no less than five days and no more than 180. Upon completion, students will receive a certificate of completion to share with the Behavior Analyst Certification Board. Partial credit will not be awarded. While you are enrolled in the course, you may contact the instructors with your questions. Instructors will reply within two business days.

**This training program is based on the Registered Behavior Technician 2<sup>nd</sup> Edition Task List and is designed to meet the 40-hour training requirement for the RBT credential. This program does NOT include the supervision and exam portions of the requirements. The program is offered independent of the BACB.
