## Extended Evidence Outcomes - Review and Revision Process



As part of the Colorado Academic Standards (CAS) review and revision process, the Extended Evidence Outcomes (EEO) will be updated to align to the 2020 Colorado Academic Standards. To accomplish this important work, the Colorado Department of Education will be forming a Review and Revision Committee for the (a) mathematics; (b) reading, writing and communicating; (c) science; and (d) social studies content areas. A chair or co-chair will be selected from the membership of each committee.

The Colorado Department of Education (CDE) is committed to conducting an open and transparent standards review and revision process by engaging diverse stakeholders from across the state. Our review and revision work will require P-12 experts in the stated content areas and/or experts in the specialized instruction of students with the most significant cognitive disabilities. We are requesting your assistance, please consider applying for this important work.

Applicants must be able to serve on the committee for the duration of the process (March – July 2019). In addition, committee members will be responsible for the following requirements:

- Participating in all face-to-face meetings (two full one-day meetings per content area)
- Completing activities prior to and in between face-to-face meetings
- Participating in all online review and revision meetings
- Meeting the deadlines

1. Applications must be submitted online by 5:00 p.m. on March 12, 2019.
2. Applicants will be notified of acceptance by March 18, 2019.
3. Applicants may apply for more than one content area, but may only be chosen for one based on the number and expertise of the applicants.
