How does DIBELS Deep differ from DIBELS Next?

Basic Early Literacy Skills

Phonemic Awareness

- The ability to hear, identify, and manipulate individual sounds (phonemes) in spoken words

Phonics

- The system of letter–sound relationships that is the foundation for decoding words

Accurate and Fluent Reading of Connected Text

Reading Comprehension

Vocabulary and Language Skills

DIBELS Deep

What?

- Research-based, approved diagnostic assessment
- Individually administered
- Untimed
- Brief (~10 minutes each)
- Easy to administer
- Linked to DIBELS Next/
Acadience Reading
- Skill sequence corresponds to
recognized sequences of instruction



DIBELS Deep

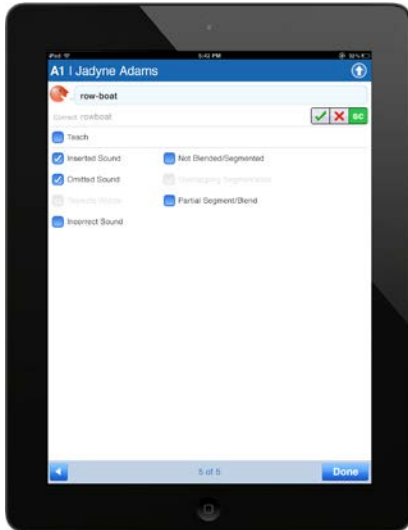
Who?

- Students who do not meet DIBELS Next Benchmark goals
- Students who are not making adequate progress
- Any student for whom you need additional information about instructional needs

DIBELS Deep

Where?

- mCLASS app on mobile device
mclass.amplify.com/assessment
- Student-facing materials are in the kit



DIBELS Deep

When?

- After Benchmark assessment
- Whenever you need more information about a student's instructional needs
- Administer within 60 days of the first identification of Significant Reading Deficiency

DIBELS Deep

More effectively target instruction for struggling readers

Why?

Use information from diagnostic assessment to inform READ Plan.

Answer questions such as:



- What types of support do students need?
- How should students be grouped?
- What specific skills should be the focus of instruction?
- Which instructional strategies are effective?







Not designed for making high-stakes decisions (e.g., retention, grades, special education eligibility, teacher evaluation).

DIBELS Deep

How?

- Breaks early reading skills into a sequence of discrete components
- Offers teachers opportunities to discover effective instructional strategies
- Shows teachers where to target instruction

E3! Teaching the Task  

<input type="checkbox"/>	Use the four-sound box strip. Move a chip or other tangible item into a box for each phoneme as you say the word, or touch a box on the strip for each phoneme as you say the word.  Have the student do the above with you.
	Clap or tap the phonemes of the word.  Have the student clap the phonemes of the word with you.
	Place the appropriate number of cubes in front of the student. Touch and/or move a cube for each phoneme as you say the word.  Have the student touch and/or move the cubes along with you—one for each phoneme—as he/she says the word with you.

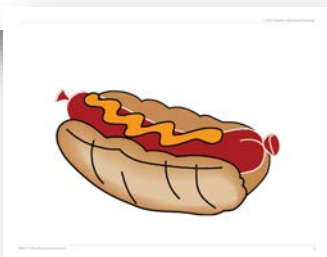

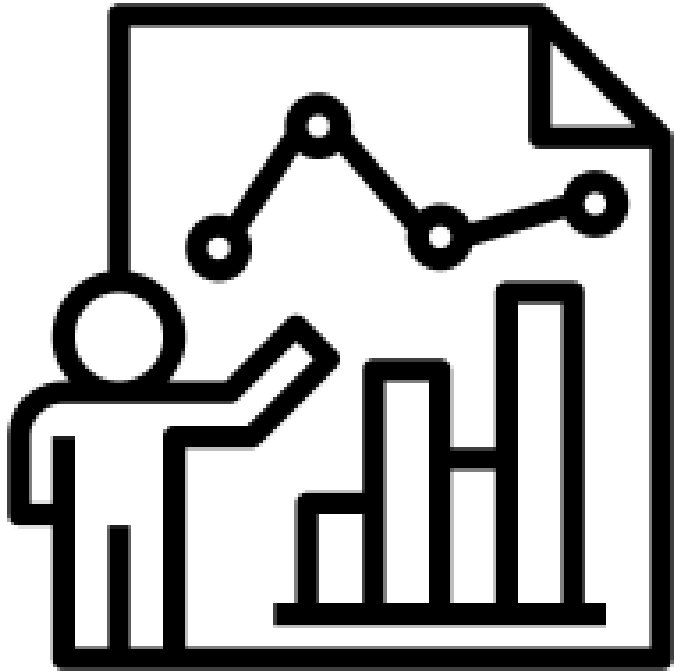
Online training: DIBELS Deep Phonemic Awareness and Word Reading and Decoding (PA & WRD)
