2025-26 Significant Reading Deficiency (SRD) Cut Scores in Colorado

Star Early Learning Spanish

Star Early Learning Spanish, included with every purchase of Star Early Learning in English, is comprised of Star Alfabetización temprana (K-3) and Star Lectura (1-8)¹.

To determine SRD for your students, simply use the default screening benchmarks in Star Alfabetización temprana and Star Lectura. A scaled score placing the student in the 25th percentile rank or lower means the student should be classified as SRD. Use the table below to identify the cut scores² for each screening window. To report READ Act data to the state, pull the necessary Unified Scale scores directly from the Renaissance platform.

The Star Early Learning Spanish scaled score range is 200-1400 SS.

- Star Alfabetización temprana – 200-1100 SS
- Star Lectura – 600-1400 SS

¹ Star assessments have been renamed to better reflect the importance and value of providing authentically developed Spanish reading assessments. The suite of Star assessments in Spanish is now Star Evaluaciones; Star Early Literacy Spanish is now Star Alfabetización temprana; Star Reading Spanish is now Star Lectura.

² Educators will notice that the cut score needed to achieve this benchmark is lower than last year. This is because Star Alfabetización was re-normed in 2025. The benchmark for identifying SRD remains at the 25th percentile.
