*Social studies assessments are administered on a sampling basis with schools participating once every three years. This year, approximately 1/3 of schools will participate in social studies testing in grades 4, 7, and 11.

**Students who elect to take the additional optional essay will add about an hour to their SAT testing time, including breaks.

When will tests be given?

CMAS Tests

CMAS tests in English language arts/literacy, math, science and social studies will be administered in one window from **April 8-26**. All elementary and middle school science and social studies tests must be scheduled and completed during the April 8-26 testing window. Districts may request to administer the high school science and social studies tests as early as March 25. Districts may also request an extended test window for ELA and math, only for online testing, due to limited device availability as early as March 18.

College Board's High School Assessments

Colorado's ninth- and 10th-grade students will continue to take the PSAT, and 11th-grade students will take the SAT. The 2019 test date for the SAT is **April 9**. Districts may choose **April 9**, **10** or **11** as their PSAT test date.
