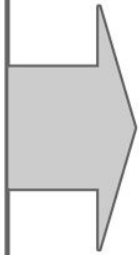

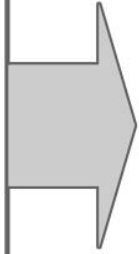

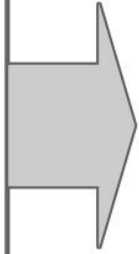

Read the document at least twice. Circle words that you do not understand. Then, answer the questions.

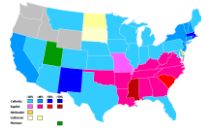
1. In what year was the Treaty written?

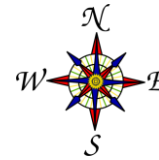

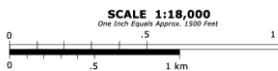
