Students may only be reported for Early Intervening Services if your Administrative Unit/State Operated Program chose to use up to 15 percent (CEIS) or was required to use 15 percent (CCEIS) of its IDEA: Part B funds for Early Intervening Services, and had an approved Federal Application Narrative for the use of those funds.

#### **CEIS File**

**Admin Unit/SOP Code** - A unique code assigned to an Administrative Unit/State Operated Program by CDE. Refer to Administrative Unit/State Operated Program Codes in Student Code Table document.

Student's State ID (SASID) – A unique ten digit number assigned to each student by CDE's Record Integration System (RITS).

**Student's First Name** – A name given to an individual at birth, baptism, or during another naming ceremony, or through legal change.

**Student's Last Name** – The name borne in common by members of a family.

Student's Gender - An individual's sex.
