

# 2025-2026 Student Restraint and Seclusion Data

### Purpose:

Per C.R.S. 22-1-139(1)(b)(VII) and (VIII); the number of students physically restrained, and the number of students placed in seclusion must be collected and reported by the Department of Education.

#### **Dependencies:**

The student has been assigned a SASID and updated in the RITS system. The student is reported in the Student Demographic file by the same reporting district/BOCES. The student's federal race/ethnicity and English Learner Status will be determined by the student demographic file.

#### **Record Expectation:**

Each record represents a student either physically restrained or placed in seclusion. Each occurrence represents one record in the data file

#### Use Summary:

This file will be used for the Protection of Persons from Restraint Act (PPRA) data reporting requirements and the posted District Profile Reports per C.R.S. 22-1-139(1)(b)(VII) and (VIII) and Colorado State Board Rule 1 CCR 301-45.

# Data Field Descriptions:

# School District/BOCES Code

A unique code assigned to a district by CDE. <u>Refer to School District/BOCES Code table.</u>

### School Code

A unique code assigned by CDE to a school building. <u>Refer to School Building Codes posted on the CDE frequently requested codes' page.</u>

### **Case Identifier**

A unique identifier for each case where a student was physically restrained or secluded. This identifier must be unique for all records.

## Student's State ID (SASID)

A unique ten-digit number must be assigned to each student by CDE.



#### Local ID (LASID)

The student's Locally Assigned Student ID (LASID). LEAs may zero fill if they choose not to use a LASID.

#### Student's First Name

A name given to an individual at birth, baptism, or during another naming ceremony, or through legal change.

#### Student's Last Name

The name borne in common by members of a family.

#### Student's Gender

An individual's sex.

Code	Description
01	Female - identifies as female (including a transgender student who identifies exclusively as female)
02	Male - identifies as male (including a transgender student who identifies exclusively as male)
03	<b>Nonbinary</b> - does not identify exclusively as male or female. Nonbinary does not refer to a transgender student who identifies exclusively as either male or female.

#### Student's Date of Birth

The month, day, and year in which an individual was born (i.e., 04101995).

#### **Grade Level**

The grade level of the student reported as restrained or placed in seclusion.

#### Section 504 Having a Disability Indicator

The student was identified as having a disability under regulations implementing Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 at the time of the restraint or seclusion.

#### **Physically Restrained Indicator**

An indicator if the student was physically restrained with the length of time physically restrained. Physically Restrained is defined in statute and Colorado State Board of Education Rules; both definitions are below.

**26-20-102(5)** "Physical restraint" means the use of bodily, physical force to involuntarily limit an individual's freedom of movement for more than one minute; except that "physical restraint" does not include the holding of a child by one adult for the purposes of calming or comforting the child.

**1 CCR 301-45.2.00(8)(c)** "Physical Restraint" means the use of bodily, physical force to involuntarily limit an individual's freedom of movement.

Code	Description

01	Yes, less than 1 minute
02	Yes, it was between 1:00 to 4:59 minutes
03	Yes, for 5 minutes or more



#### **Seclusion Indicator**

An indicator if the student was placed in seclusion. Seclusion is defined in statute and Colorado State Board of Education Rules; both definitions are below.

**26-20-102(7)** "Seclusion" means the placement of an individual alone in a room or area from which egress is involuntarily prevented, except during normal sleeping hours.

**1 CCR 301-45.2.00(9)** "Seclusion" means the placement of a student alone in a room from which egress is involuntarily prevented. "Seclusion" does not mean:

- 2.00(9)(a) Placement of a student in residential services in his or her room for the night; or
- 2.00(9)(b) "Time-out" which is the removal of a student from potentially rewarding people or situations. A Time-out is not used primarily to confine the student, but to limit accessibility to reinforcement. In a Time-out, the individual is not physically prevented from leaving the designated Time-out area. Such a Time-out requires effective monitoring by staff

# Additional Calculated Fields

These fields will be calculated using the student demographic file record for each student. This information is not included in the periodic file layout but will be utilized for reporting purposes by CDE.

#### Student's Federal Race/Ethnicity

The single category used to classify the student or staff member in aggregated federal or state reporting. This designation is based on the race and ethnicity information provided to the reporting district by the student (or their parent/guardian) or staff member.

#### Multilingual Learner Y/N (formerly English Learner)

The English Learner (ELL) status for the student record. If the student's Language Background is not 'eng' and Language Profyh5iciency = 1, 2, 6, or 7 (NEP, LEP, FEP Monitor Year 1, or FEP Monitor Year 2) then the ELL status is '1' (Yes). Students with Language Proficiency = 0, 4, 5, 8, 9 (N/A, PHLOTE, FELL, FEP Exit Year 1, or FEP Exit Year 2) are indicated as '0' (No).
