

Census Block Data: 4 Components

- 1. State Code
- 2. County Code
- 3. Tract Code
- 4. Block Code

Using all 4 components gives each household a specific, unique coding pattern:

- Piecemealing components together most likely will result in an inaccurate Census block data
- It's possible to have many combinations with the same tract and block codes within the same county code


- Navigate to the <u>Data Pipeline Webpage</u> and login
- Find "Pipeline Reports" on the lefthand menu
 - Click "Error Report"
 - Dataset: At Risk Measure Interchange
 - File Type: At Risk Measure Interchange
 - School Year: 2025-26
 - Organization/LEA: [Your district]
 - **Error Type:** Errors and Warnings
 - Errors must be corrected
 - Warnings need investigation but could be okay
 - Click "Search"
- Match error codes with those found on the At-Risk Interchange <u>Business</u> Rules to troubleshoot

Address on File- Did Not Attempt to Obtain Census Block Data: The district has a primary physical address on file but did NOT attempt to obtain census block data using the geocode tool.	08	000
