Diploma Planning Institute Training:

- **What:** 1.5 day Diploma Planning Institute –A team of experts from the National Dropout Prevention Center (NDPC) will train and guide school or district teams to analyze local data and circumstances and to develop and implement research-based dropout prevention plans. - **Audience:** Alternative Education Campuses (AECs), alternative education program teams, Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) Low Grad rate schools, and school and districts rates that are *approaching* or *do not meet* the state's Postsecondary and Workforce Readiness (PWR) indicators.
- ***Cost:** \$150 Per person
