Grant Overview

The Colorado Student Re-engagement Grant Program is authorized by C.R.S. 22-14-109.

The purpose is to assist in providing educational services and supports that will maintain student engagement and promote student re-engagement.

It funds innovations and proven strategies to strengthen school engagement, postsecondary and workforce readiness, and address barriers to school completion.

Priority is given to eligible applicants from high-need schools.

Grant Award Summary

Grant Guidelines

- Funding is contingent on legislative appropriation
- 3-year grant terms
- Only local education providers are eligible to apply
- Application components are outlined in statute
- An annual evaluation of the grant program shall include reporting on outcomes, such as:
 - Graduation and dropout rates
 - Suspension and expulsion rates
 - Student engagement and re-engagement rates

Competitive Grant Process

- \$1.94 million appropriated for awards
- \$7.5 million in requests from 48 applicants
- Reviewers used a grant scoring rubric to rate each application
- 27 applicants met the criteria for funding
- Based on funds available, 10 of the 27 qualifying applicants are recommended for awards
