

Evaluator Training: Locally Created Training Review Rubric and Scoring Overview

The following rubric will be used to review evaluator training packages submitted by school districts/BOCES (or any other provider other than CDE) seeking approval of a locally created evaluator training program to satisfy the required evaluator training standards and elements in State Board rule (1 CCR 301-87, 5.3 (H)).

Each criteria will be scored on the following ratings: exceeds (3 points); meets (2 points); present and does not meet (1 point); absent (0 - no points).

An average from scores of all criteria (32) within all Training Standards (I-V) and all 16 Elements will determine the recommendation for approval - see score ranges and corresponding recommendations at the end of this rubric.

Each submission will be reviewed by members of the Educator Effectiveness Office, with the EE Regional Specialist for the district/BOCES taking the lead role in the review process. All submissions will be reviewed and will receive feedback and support for next steps in the implementation of their training program.

	The training program does not meet the criteria for the required training standards and elements. Additional information is needed and possible re-submission prior to approval per input from EE Team.	0 - 0.9 = Not Approved

If any criteria is determined to be absent, approval for the training program is not possible until item is present, and ideally meets or exceeds the standard/criteria.

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
