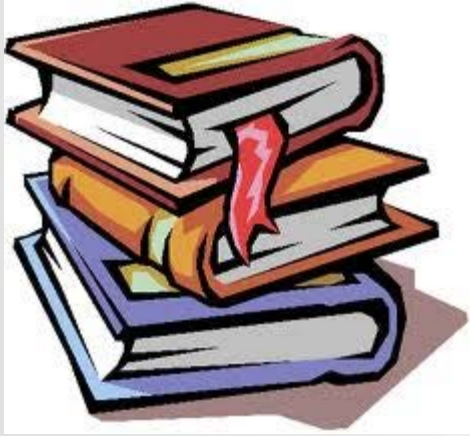
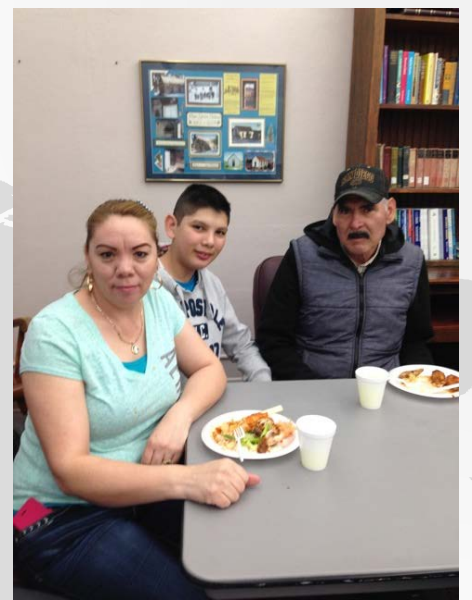


# ADULT LITERACY CLASS



A class to learn English with other adults in the community. Students practice speaking, expand their vocabulary, improve grammar and read with understanding.

Twice a week during the school year the district conducts a Family Literacy program for Non English Proficient parents taught by an Adult ESL instructor. In the past, an average of 10 parents enrolled in the class. Research-based instructional strategies are used. The focus is on Newcomer needs as well as individual student needs.
