## STATE COUNCIL FOR EDUCATOR EFFECTIVENESS

## MEETING HIGHLIGHTS



March 25, 2011

At its March 25<sup>th</sup> meeting, the State Council for Educator Effectiveness (SCEE) deliberated refined language for recommendations about a statewide scoring framework that would be used to assign educators to performance levels. It also refined language for recommendations about the pilot phase of implementation and an appeals process.

The Council reached consensus on the following recommendations:

- 1. Student engagement
- 2. Parent/guardian engagement
- 3. Measuring student growth for use in principal evaluations
- 4. Measuring professional practice for use in principal evaluations
- 5. Guidelines for CDE implementation: Roles of the State Model System
- 6. Guidelines for CDE implementation: Piloting the New Evaluation System
- 7. State Scoring Framework

The Council reviewed and approved modest wording changes to the following recommendations previously called to consensus:

- 1. Development of student growth measures
- 2. Measuring student growth for use in teacher evaluations

The Council reviewed a report from the working group charged with developing initial draft of recommended guidelines for appeals to a second "ineffective" rating. The Council is charged with delivering this recommendation to the General Assembly by January 2013.

Finally, the Council reviewed and provided input into draft sections of its final report.

The Council will meet again on Friday, April 8th at to review its final report.

The Council will present its recommendations to the State Board of Education at 10:00am on Wednesday, April 13<sup>th</sup>.
