# CDE ELDT Theory and Behind the Wheel Instructor Classes

The United States Congress, in the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act (MAP-21), mandates training for first-time CDL applicants and current CDL holders seeking a license upgrade Effective February 7, 2022.

MAP-21 also includes mandatory requirements for instructors and training providers.

Satisfactory completion of the CDE ELDT Theory and/or Behind the Wheel Instructor Class will qualify you to become a ELDT Instructor for the Department of Education in the State of Colorado.

The Theory and the Behind the Wheel Instructor classes are approximately 4 hours each.

These classes are offered free of charge.
