The Exceptional Children’s Educational Act (ECEA) contains provisions related to costs for educating students with disabilities who enroll in and attend a district or institute charter school. When a child with a disability enrolls in and attends a public charter school, the district of residence is responsible for paying the excess costs incurred in educating the student. The district of residence is only required to pay the costs when the charter school or chartering authority applies to CDE.
