<b>Allowable Meals</b>	Up to 2 meals per child per day: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Breakfast + lunch/supper OR</li> <li>• Any one meal + snack</li> </ul> *Up to 3 meals per day for camps and migrant sites	Same, <b>except</b> When impacted by Covid-19 and approved by CDE, sites may serve meals for multiple days at the same time (within usual per child per day limits)
<b>Area Eligibility</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Open sites: located in eligible areas with ≥50% free/reduced-price eligible based on school or census data</li> <li>• Closed enrolled sites: ≥50% of enrolled participants must be documented as free/reduced-price eligible. May qualify using area eligibility (CO state waiver)</li> </ul> *Different for camps and migrant sites	Same, <b>plus</b> additional options to determine area eligibility are available: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use School Year19-20 School Data</li> <li>• Use Community Eligibility Program Data</li> </ul>
<b>Reimbursement Rates</b>	SFSP combined reimbursement <a href="#">rate</a> for rural/self- prep or vended	Same
<b>Meal Claiming</b>	All meals are claimed at the free rate *Different for camps	Same
<b>Days of Operation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Allows for weekend service and service up to seven days per week</li> <li>• Allows for service on holidays during summer break or intersession breaks for students attending year-round schools</li> <li>• Service during planned school closures or non-school days during the regular school year (like spring break) is not permitted</li> </ul>	Same
<b>Meal Pattern</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">SFSP</a> or <a href="#">National School Lunch Program</a> Meal Pattern allowed</li> </ul> *NSLP for school sites only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Offer versus serve is allowed for all program sponsors (CO state waiver)</li> </ul>	Same
<b>Meal Service Times</b>	No restrictions on time between meals or length of service (CO state waiver)	Same
<b>Congregate Feeding/Parent Pick Up</b>	Congregate meal service required (children must be served and eat each meal on site in a supervised setting)	Same, <b>except</b> When impacted by Covid-19 and approved by CDE, non-congregate feeding and parent pickup are allowed
<b>Daily Meal Counts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Meal counts, separated by meal type and by:                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o First meals served to children</li> <li>o Second meals served to children</li> <li>o Meals served to adults performing food service labor (allowable cost but not reimbursed)</li> <li>o Meals served to non-program adults, if any (neither allowable cost nor reimbursable)</li> <li>o Excess or leftover meals (not reimbursed)</li> <li>o Non-reimbursable meals (not reimbursed)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	Same, <b>except</b> When impacted by Covid-19 and approved by CDE, sites may serve meals for multiple days at the same time. Use one daily meal count form to record multiple days of meals served at a time
<b>Site Monitoring</b>	SFSP sponsors are required to conduct: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o A pre-operational site visit,</li> <li>o A first week site visit, and</li> <li>o A review of the site's food service within the first four weeks of the site's operations</li> </ul> *Pre-operational and first week site visits are waived for sites that successfully operated in previous years and sites that operate the Child and Adult Care Food Program/NSLP (CO state waiver)	Same
